Pomegranate Margarita



Serves 4

INGREDIENTS

- Lime wedges
- Salt & Ice
- 4 ounces white tequila
- 2 ounces Triple Sec
- 1/2 cup pomegranate juice
- 1 lime, juiced (optional)
- Club soda

DIRECTIONS

Pour salt onto a plate or shallow dish. With a lime wedge rub along the rim of a glass and dip glasses upside down to salt the rim. Fill glasses with ice. In a cocktail shaker with ice place the tequila, triple sec, pomegranate juice, and lime juice. Pour into the salt-rimmed glasses and top off with club soda. Garnish with a lime wedge, if desired.

Pomegranate Lime Soda

INGREDIENTS

- 16 ounces pomegranate juice
- 8 ounces seltzer water
- 1/4 cup lime juice
- 1/2 cup sugar



Serves 4

Tip: Add some zing by substituting ginger ale for seltzer water, or add a pinch of finely grated fresh ginger to the punch.

DIRECTIONS

In a pitcher or bowl, combine ingredients. Serve chilled over ice, garnish with lime wedges.

Tip: For long-lasting flavor, freeze pomegranate juice in ice cube trays and pour pre-mixed punch over them.
