



Santy Claus Grinch Treats

There's no great Grinchy trick at work here—these treats are both delicious and good for you!

Ingredients

- a bunch of large green grapes
- fresh raspberries
- bananas
- apples
- 2 tablespoons of cream cheese
- 4-6 tablespoons sugar
- juice from half a small lemon
- toothpicks or small skewers
- an icing bag or a non-pleated closable plastic sandwich bag

Directions

Wash an apple, grapes and raspberries and dry thoroughly. Cut the apple in half and place the halves flat side down on a plate. While the other fruit is draining, mix up the cream cheese, confectioners sugar and about a teaspoon of lemon juice. Blend until smooth and fairly thick. Put the icing in an icing bag with a small tip or cut a small corner from a plastic sandwich bag.

Put a grape on a toothpick and add a raspberry so it fits closely over the top of the grape. Use your icing bag to pipe white trim around the bottom of the raspberry and add a small dollop on the very top of the berry for the hat's pompom. To let the icing dry, push the bottom end of the toothpick into an apple half.
