



Dreamcatcher snack mix

A big bowl of salty-sweet snack twists provides good munching during family movie night or whenever you're in the mood for a quick-and-easy treat.

Ingredients

- 1 10 ounce package bear-shaped cinnamon-flavored graham snack cookies (4 cups)
- 3 ½ ounce package unpopped white cheddar or cheddar microwave popcorn, cooked according to package directions, or 9 cups packaged white cheddar popcorn
- 1 cup chocolate-covered raisins
- ¼ cup butter, melted
- ½ teaspoon garlic salt
- 1 ½ cups red candy twist bites.

Directions

In a bowl combine cookies, popcorn, and chocolate raisins. Combine butter and garlic salt. Drizzle; toss. Add candy; toss. Store in airtight container up to 24 hours. Makes 12 servings.

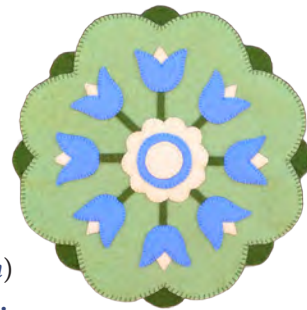
