embroidery thread (40wt) to appliqué stitch. The sheen from the polyester thread contrasts nicely with the flat surface of the felt. I also stitched a piece of felt to the back of the wall hanging to cover up all of my starts and stops of stitching to give it a nice clean look. No need for batting in doing it this way as I used the felt background piece as my batting."
